Historically associated with ancient legends connected to the Sun Temple.</p>

<p>DAY 4</p>	<p align="center">CHILIKA LAKE EXCURSION & BHUBANESWAR SIGHTSEEING</p> <p>Nature, Dolphins & Ancient Temples</p> <p>Early morning drive to:</p> <p>Satapada</p> <p>Gateway to the famous Chilika lagoon.</p> <p>Explore:</p> <p>Chilika Lake</p> <p>Asia's largest brackish water lagoon and one of India's most important ecological zones.</p> <p>Highlights:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Boat ride through the lagoon • Irrawaddy dolphin spotting • Sea mouth views where the lake meets the Bay of Bengal • Migratory birds (<i>seasonal</i>) <p>Proceed towards Bhubaneswar for sightseeing.</p> <p>Visit:</p> <p>Lingaraj Temple</p> <p>A masterpiece of Kalinga temple architecture dedicated to Lord Shiva and one of Odisha's most important temples.</p> <p>Dhuli Shanti Stupa</p> <p>Located near the site of the historic Kalinga War, this peaceful white pagoda symbolizes Emperor Ashoka's transformation towards Buddhism and non-violence.</p>	 

	<p>Mukteswara Temple</p> <p>A beautifully carved 10th-century temple often called the “Gem of Odisha Architecture.”</p> <p>Udayagiri and Khandagiri Caves</p> <p>Ancient rock-cut caves associated with Jain monks and early Odisha history.</p>
