<p><b>DAY 1</b></p>	<p align="center"><b>ARRIVAL IN RANCHI &amp; LOCAL SIGHTSEEING</b></p> <p>Arrive at Ranchi Railway Station/Airport and proceed for local exploration of Jharkhand’s capital, known for its lakes, waterfalls, and tribal heritage.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Patratu Dam &amp; Valley</b> – A scenic reservoir surrounded by winding valley roads and lush green hills, offering breathtaking panoramic views.</li> <li>• <b>Kanke Dam</b> – A peaceful water body ideal for sunset views and leisure walks amidst calm surroundings.</li> <li>• <b>Rock Garden</b> – A creatively designed park built from natural rock formations offering lake views and photo points.</li> <li>• <b>Birsa Munda Jail Museum</b> – A historic site dedicated to tribal freedom fighter Birsa Munda, showcasing India’s freedom struggle history.</li> </ul> <p><b>Overnight stay in Ranchi.</b></p>
<p><b>DAY 2</b></p>	<p align="center"><b>RANCHI → NETARHAT (HILL STATION DRIVE)</b></p> <p>After breakfast, proceed towards Netarhat – famously known as the “Queen of Chotanagpur”, a serene hill station known for its sunrise and sunset views.</p>



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Netarhat School</b> – One of the oldest and most prestigious residential schools of Bihar/Jharkhand, known for producing top civil servants.</li> <li>• <b>Netarhat Dam</b> – A calm reservoir surrounded by dense forests, offering a peaceful natural retreat.</li> <li>• <b>Lower Ghaghri Waterfall</b> – A hidden forest waterfall cascading through rocky terrain, ideal for nature lovers.</li> <li>• <b>Chalet House</b> – A colonial-era forest rest house offering nostalgic charm and panoramic valley views.</li> <li>• <b>Koel View Point &amp; Pine Forest</b> – A mesmerizing viewpoint overlooking the Koel River valley framed by tall pine trees.</li> <li>• <b>Nashpati Bagan (Pear Orchard)</b> – A seasonal orchard landscape adding a unique rural charm to Netarhat’s beauty.</li> <li>• <b>Magnolia / Sunset Point</b> – The most iconic viewpoint of Netarhat, famous for its golden sunset dipping into layers of forested hills.</li> </ul> <p><b>Overnight stay in Netarhat.</b></p>		
<p><b>DAY 3</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>NETARHAT → BETLA</b></p> <p>Begin early to witness the magical sunrise before departing for Betla, known for its wildlife and dense forest ecosystem.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Sunrise Point (Netarhat)</b> – A surreal early morning experience where the sun rises over rolling hills and mist-covered valleys.</li> </ul>		



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Lodh Falls (on route)</b> – The highest waterfall in Jharkhand, plunging dramatically from forested cliffs into deep gorges.</li> </ul> <p>Upon arrival in Betla:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Betla National Park (Jeep Safari – Direct Payment)</b> – One of India’s early tiger reserves, home to elephants, deer, leopards, and rich biodiversity in a dense Sal forest ecosystem.</li> </ul> <p><b>Overnight stay in Betla.</b></p>	
<p><b>DAY 4</b></p>	<p align="center"><b>BETLA → RANCHI (RETURN JOURNEY WITH SIGHTSEEING)</b></p> <p>After breakfast, begin return journey to Ranchi with scenic and cultural stops en route.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Sugga Bandh</b> – A natural waterfall surrounded by thick forest terrain, offering a refreshing halt.</li> <li>• <b>Palamu Fort</b> – Ancient fort ruins reflecting the medieval history of the Chero dynasty, set amidst forested surroundings.</li> <li>• <b>Tattapani Hot Water Spring</b> – A natural geothermal spring believed to have medicinal properties and spiritual significance.</li> <li>• <b>Mirchaiya Falls</b> – A picturesque waterfall hidden within dense greenery, ideal for short nature breaks.</li> <li>• <b>Kechki Sangam</b> – The confluence of the North Koel and Auranga rivers, known for its scenic river views.</li> </ul> <p><b>Overnight stay in Ranchi.</b></p>	 



<b>DAY 5</b>	<b>RANCHI DEPARTURE &amp; SIGHTSEEING</b>
	<p>After breakfast, enjoy remaining sightseeing before departure.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Jagannath Temple</b> – A replica of Puri’s famous temple, situated on a hilltop offering panoramic views of Ranchi city.</li> <li>• <b>Hundru Falls</b> – One of the highest waterfalls in Jharkhand, formed by the Subarnarekha River, especially dramatic during monsoon.</li> <li>• <b>Jonha Falls (Gautamdharma)</b> – A sacred waterfall believed to be associated with Lord Buddha’s followers, reached via a scenic descent of steps.</li> <li>• <b>Getalsud Dam</b> – A large reservoir offering peaceful waterscapes and a relaxing final stop before departure.</li> </ul> <p><b>Drop at Railway Station / Airport</b></p>
